REPLACEMENT SUSPENSION SPRINGS

ISSUE:

In production, suspension springs are allocated to one of two grades, depending on the tolerance of the overall length of the spring.

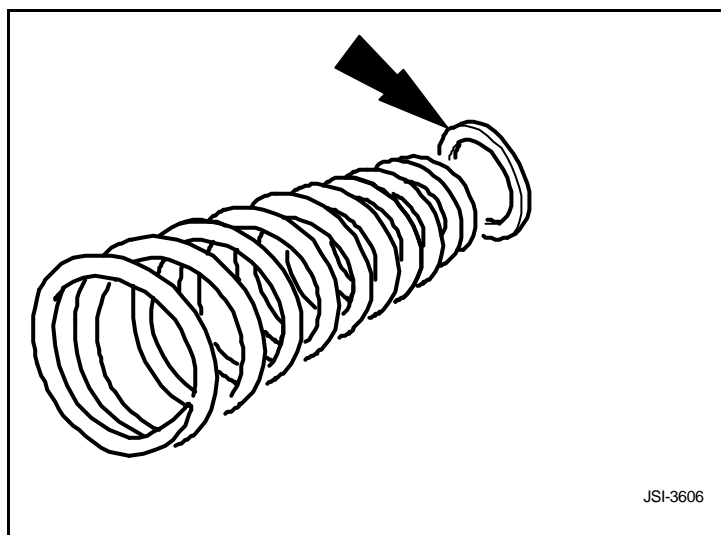
When 'short-tolerance' springs are built up into suspension assemblies, a 3mm packing ring is inserted under the spring, to maintain the correct ride height of the vehicle. No packing ring is fitted where 'long-tolerance' springs are assembled. Any one vehicle may have any combination of 'long-tolerance' and 'short-tolerance' springs fitted as original equipment.

All replacement springs supplied via Jaguar Parts Operations are selected as 'long' tolerance springs, and **must not** have packing rings fitted below them.

ACTION:

Where it is necessary to fit a replacement spring to an S-Type vehicle, examine the existing condition.

In any location where a 3mm packing ring is found under the existing spring, discard the packing ring before fitting the replacement spring.
